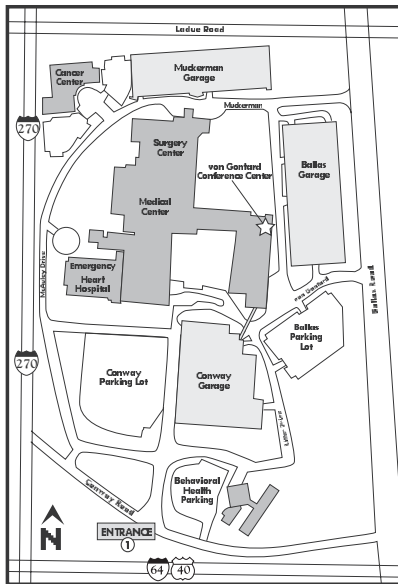
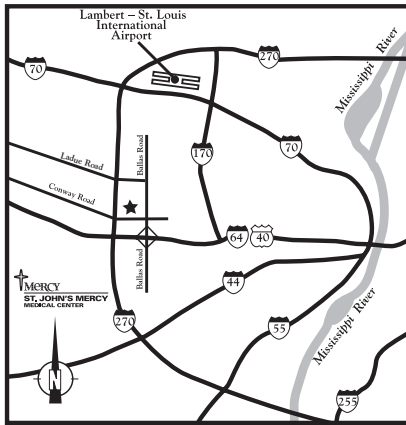

The Trauma Nursing Core Course utilizes a systematic approach in providing initial care of the trauma patient. This trauma nursing process is incorporated into both the lecture and skill station components. Epidemiology, mechanism of injury and initial assessment and intervention provide the basic components. The pathophysiology of shock and trauma to specific organ systems also are described. Specialized needs of the pediatric and pregnant trauma patients are new additions to the course. Newly revised and updated skill stations include initial assessment and intervention, airway and spinal immobilization.

Registration

Registration is limited to ensure an optimal instructor/student ratio. The following requirements must be met prior to enrollment:

- Must be a registered nurse
- At least six months of Emergency Department or Critical Care experience is recommended

NOTE: All decisions regarding admission and course operation will be made by the course director.

Registration Deadline Dates

The registration deadline is 6 weeks prior to the course date. Early registration is advised to guarantee enrollment. All registrants will receive a confirmation letter and study packet approximately one month prior to the course. **If you do not receive this information, please check with your institution.** If any questions remain, contact us at 314-251-4961.

Cancellations

Written notice of cancellation must be received two weeks prior to the course date. A \$50 processing fee will be deducted from all cancellation requests. No refunds can be made less than two weeks prior to the course date.

Overview

This course is offered to registered nurses who care for victims of trauma. It is designed to provide a consistent, standardized knowledge base and approach to caring for the trauma victim. Lectures, performance skill labs, written tests and skill station performance tests are utilized in this course.

Objectives

At the conclusion of this two-day course, the participants will be better able to:

1. Demonstrate initial assessment and intervention of a mock trauma victim utilizing the primary and secondary surveys.
2. Demonstrate proper skills and sequencing in clearing an airway, selecting an appropriate oxygen delivery device and verifying the placement of an endotracheal tube.
3. Perform the proper steps in removing the spinal immobilization for the trauma patient.

Continuing Education Contact Hours

The Emergency Nurses Association is accredited as a provider of continuing nursing education by the American Nurses Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation. This course provides 14.42 contact hours which are provided to participants who attend the entire TNCC course, regardless of their testing performance.
